

2019–2020 Academic Year Scholarships for Accounting Majors

The Clark Nuber scholarship program is now accepting applications for non-renewable tuition scholarships. These scholarships will be awarded to accounting students entering at least their junior year by Fall 2019 at any four-year accredited institution in or near Washington State.

Eligibility: Accounting students who will have completed their sophomore year by Summer 2019 at an accredited four-year institution in or near Washington State. All applicants must be eligible to work without sponsorship after graduation. Preference will be given to residents of Washington State. Scholarship recipients will automatically receive an on-campus interview provided they submit a complete application packet prior to the on-campus interview deadline.

Deadline: Completed applications and other required documents should be submitted through Clark Nuber’s website by **March 31, 2019** (www.clarknuber.com/careers/scholarships/):

Unofficial college transcripts are acceptable.

Scholarships: The 2019-2020 scholarships available are:

6-\$1,000 merit-based scholarships (used for tuition only)

Multiple scholarships may be awarded per University.

Selection Criteria:

Clark Nuber will screen all applications received and select the finalists based upon criteria that includes but is not limited to:

- 1) Academic achievement (minimum 3.0 GPA)
 - 2) Campus and/or community activities
 - 3) Work history
 - 4) Responses to short essay questions
 - 5) Two letters of recommendation
 - 6) Probability of success/obtaining a CPA license
